JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS

JUNIOR FAMILY MEMBERS

- Junior Family Member is any child, grandchild, or other direct descendant of a current member in good standing between the ages of 16 and 21 inclusive.
- Junior Family Member must file a membership application and have 2 sponsors (current club regular members, not related) to apply for membership.
- Junior Family Member will not have boat docking, mooring, or overnight storage rights. Junior Family Member shall be permitted to use the boat of their Regular Member family member or any other Regular Member so long as that approval is documented with the club in writing. Use of boats of other Regular Member's without express written permission is strictly prohibited. The use of club owned boats is permitted, excluding the work pontoon boat. The use of personal unpowered watercraft (canoe, kayak, SUP, etc.) is permitted.
- Junior Family Member shall be allowed at the club during daylight hours only without the related Regular Member present. No overnight stays permitted.
- A Junior Family Member does not have voting rights but is encouraged to attend member meetings.
- Junior Family Member shall pay yearly dues in the amount of 20% of Regular Member yearly dues. No initiation fee shall be assessed. A Junior Family Member may request, prior the Junior Family Member's 22nd birthday, to be converted to a regular membership with full rights and shall pay regular membership fees. No initiation fee shall be assessed. At the discretion of the board, upon petition of the member, the Junior Family Membership may be extended beyond the members 22nd birthday, so long as they are enrolled in college at that time. Petition shall include an end date of the Junior Family Member.
- Junior Family Member must pass the Boat Pennsylvania Course or other recognized certified boating safety course (NASBLA-approved boating course, Coast Guard Auxiliary, US Power Squadron, BoatEd, etc.) AND must have boating competency approval from a member of the board of directors.

- Junior Family Member may have up to 3 additional guests (over the age of 16) present with them. Parties, gatherings, or other group activities are not permitted. Same rules of conduct apply to a Junior Family Member as a Regular Member.
- If the Junior Family Member or any guests are under the age of 21, no alcohol may be possessed, consumed, transported, or otherwise involved by the Junior Family Member or any guests, even if some members of the party are over the age of 21, unless the parents of the Junior Family Member are present or it is a sanctioned club event (club parties, work parties).
- All Junior Family Member's shall be issued a Junior Family Member membership card and shall carry said card at all times while on club property. Junior Family Member must present this membership card immediately upon request of any Regular Member or caretaker. Failure to do so will result in removal from the club grounds.
- Immediately upon arrival at the club, all Junior Family Member's and their guests must sign the Junior Family Member log book. Junior Family Member's and their guests shall sign out prior to leaving the club for the day. Failure to sign in may be grounds for removal from the club grounds.
- Junior Family Member's shall have a one strike policy. All violations of the Junior Family Membership Rules and Regulations shall be placed before the Board of Directors for disciplinary action, up to and including revocation of Junior Family Membership without refund. The Board holds full discretion in this matter. A person whose Junior Family Membership has been revoked will be permitted at the club only with a Regular Member from that point forward until said person is eligible to re-apply for a Regular Membership (including initiation fee). Junior Family Member infractions in violation of the laws of the Commonwealth of PA may be submitted to the Pennsylvania State Police for further review.
- Junior Family Members and their family shall comply with the all Rules and Regulations and expressly waive and release the Pymatuning Century Club from any and all claims and liability.

JUNIOR MEMBERS

- A Junior Membership is targeted to high school and college students as an introductory membership. Junior Members are between the ages of 16 and 21 inclusive. At the discretion of the board, upon petition of the member, the Junior Membership may be extended beyond the members 22nd birthday if they are enrolled in college at that time.
- The same rules shall apply to the Junior Member as the Junior Family Member except that they may not be present at the club without another member (Regular Member or Junior Family Member) present. The Junior Member shall make arrangements with a Regular Member or Junior Family Member prior to arriving at the club and not expect to be allowed to enter club property just because a member is present and shall not impose upon the caretakers to be their escort without prior arrangements.
- A Junior Member may be upgraded, after age 21, in the same way as the Junior Family Member except that Junior Member's will not pay an initiation fee to become a regular member.
